We offer native perennials, shrubs, and trees and selections chosen for their smaller size or other small urban garden-appropriate habit while maintaining their environmental value and low-maintenance local adaptability. Our feeling is that it's better to grow a native plant that has been selected and grown as a genetically identical clone of the parent to fit smaller-sized space or lower height for traffic visibility when necessary than to grow an entirely non-native plant. Also included on this list for variety are non-prairie North American natives of value for wildlife habitat.

Our plants are grown in organic potting mix with mycorrhiza using biological controls and very limited OMRI approved pesticides and organic fertilizer. Planted in the right light conditions and watered regularly until established, our plants will thrive for years to come with minimal care!
