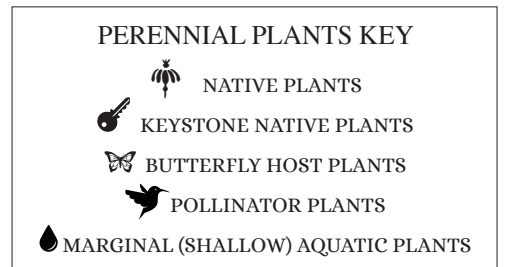

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Natives, nativars, cultivars and hybrids ...

🌿 A **NATIVE PLANT** is any annual, perennial, shrub, or tree present at a given site not introduced by people from distant places. Native plants have evolved naturally alongside wildlife and are therefore digestible by insects and other animals who play integral roles in our food web.

Native plants are adapted to local weather, soil, and other conditions making them easier to grow. As climate changes, species and ecotypes from southern regions might prove to be more robust.

A **CULTIVAR** is a plant selected for desired traits and propagated to retain those traits by division, controlled seed production, root and stem cuttings, grafting, or tissue culture. Cultivars can be native, non-native or hybrid plants. Identify cultivars on plant tags and signs by single quotation marks around a name after the botanical name — *Penstemon digitalis* 'Husker Red'.

NATIVAR is a word that has been coined to distinguish native plant cultivars. We use the term to distinguish natural variants of a native plants that have been found in the wild and brought into cultivation.

Selections are useful where straight natives have traits that make them difficult to grow in certain settings — for example, plants that are too large or spread too easily by seed for a small garden space. Native selections can still benefit wildlife.

HYBRIDS are the result of a genetic cross between two different genus or species from native or non-native plants. We do not identify hybrids of native plants as nativars at VVN.

POLLINATOR PLANTS are plants that produce flowers that provide nectar to bees, butterflies, hummingbirds and a host of creatures many of us barely even notice in our gardens. Pollinator plants can be native or non-native. Many flowering annuals are excellent nectar providers.

🦋 **HOST PLANTS** Why grow plants that feed caterpillars? Besides inviting beautiful butterflies and moths into the landscape, caterpillars are essential to songbirds rearing young. Most songbirds feed their babies a diet of insects, especially caterpillars. One study found that a chickadee family fed their babies 350 to 570 caterpillars every day.

🔑 **KEYSTONE PLANTS** provide critical food and/or shelter for a large number of species. One study found that 90% of all caterpillar diversity is centered around just 14% plant species. In limited space you can have the greatest impact by including keystone plants.

We grow more than 700 different perennials, 170 types of shrubs, and 200 kinds of trees. Of these, 40% are native plants!

We grow more than 60 keystone plants!

• WHEN TO PLANT

Trees and shrubs can be planted year-round as long as the ground isn't frozen.

Hardened off perennials (plants that have been kept outdoors in high tunnels over the winter) can be planted as early in spring as ground can be worked.

Tropicals, annuals and young seedlings of hardy plants that have been grown in the hothouse can be planted outdoors after danger of frost has passed (the last week of April is often safe). To avoid stunting plants, hot weather veggies like **tomatoes and peppers** should not be planted out until nighttime temperatures reach a minimum of 60° (usually beginning to mid-May).

• PLANTING DEPTH & MULCH

When planting, make sure the base of the trunk or stem is not planted too deep and keep mulch pulled back to allow airflow. Make sure the surface of the root ball or soil level of potted plant will be level with the surrounding soil level after settling.

• WATERING IS CRITICAL

When planting, keep in mind that the only water new plants can reach is within the relatively small existing root ball. Until new roots can grow into the surrounding soil new plantings should be watered regularly until roots become established — at least twice weekly for woody plants, more for annuals and perennials. Water slowly to allow moisture to make its way deep down into the soil, which will encourage the roots to follow.

• STAKING TREES

Staking young trees will minimize stress from wind in unprotected locations. Because the tree will continue to grow it is important to allow some movement. Check trees every three months to loosen as needed. Use fence posts and a short length of old garden hose with wire through the hose to protect the trunk of the tree from the tie wire. Remove the stakes after one to two years.
